

The safest cleaning method is using clean, warm water, applied with a soft cloth.

Acid or alkali cleaning solutions should never be used on KRYSTAL KOLOURS™. Cleaning solutions with a heavy ammonia base should also be avoided.

Any cleaning solutions used on KRYSTAL KOLOURS™ should be applied directly to the soft cleaning cloth, then wiped on the surface of the glass. Cleaning solutions should never be applied directly to the glass, or allowed to puddle along its bottom edge.

It is the responsibility of the installation team to make sure to provide the ultimate end user with proper directions for the ongoing care and cleaning of the KRYSTAL KOLOURS™ installation.

### Employer Coverage Eligibility
