CLEANING CARE AND MAINTAINCE

LAMINATED SAFETY GLASS

Cleaning and Maintenance Instructions:

Laminated glass products are very easy to maintain. Unless otherwise instructed, we suggest cleaning with warm water and a soft cloth (terry cloth). You may also use conventional, non-abrasive glass cleaners together with a soft cloth.

Glass cleaning should begin with wetting the glass surface with clean water or a mild soap solution to loosen dirt. Using a neutral, non-abrasive commercial window washing solution, uniformly apply the solution to the glass surface with a soft-bristle brush, sponge or other non-abrasive applicator. All strongly alkaline caustic solutions as well as acids, especially Hydrofluoric acid and cleaners containing fluorides are unsuitable. It is not recommend to use razor blades to clean glass, especially the 5" or 6" blades targeted toward professional window cleaners, since it has been shown that razor blade usage can result in significant glass damage.

Immediately following the application of the cleaning solution, a rubber-bladed squeegee or soft towel should be used to remove all of the cleaning solution from the glass. Care should be taken to ensure that no abrasive particles are trapped between the glass and the cleaning materials. All water and cleaning solution residue should be dried immediately from the gaskets, sealants and frames to avoid the potential deterioration of these materials.

It is strongly recommended to clean a small glass area or one window at a time, then stop and examine the surface for any damage to the glass.
